1.48, 50	Surely, from now on all generations <u>will call me blessed</u> <u>His mercy</u> is for those who fear him from generation to generation .
7.31-32	"To what then will I compare the people of this generation , and what are they like? They are <u>like children sitting in the marketplace</u> and calling to one another, 'We played the flute for you, and you did not dance; we wailed, and you did not weep.'
11.29-32	When the crowds were increasing, he began to say, "This generation is an evil generation; it asks for a sign, but no sign will be given to it except the sign of Jonah. For just as Jonah became a sign to the people of Nineveh, so the Human One will be to this generation. Genesis 7.1	Then YHWH said to Noah, "Go into the ark, you and all your household, for I have seen that <u>you alone are righteous before me in</u> this generation .
Psalm 11.8 (Eng, 12.7)	You, O <u>YHWH, will protect us; you will guard [phulassō] us from</u> this generation forever.
