22.2	He said, "Take your son, your only son Isaac, <b>whom you love</b> "
24.67	[Isaac] took Rebekah, and she became his wife; and he loved her.
25.28	Isaac loved Esau, because he was fond of game; but Rebekah loved Jacob.
27.4	Then prepare for me <b>savory food, such as I love</b> , and bring it to me to eat, so that I may bless you before I die." (again 27.9, 14)
29.18	Jacob loved Rachel (again, 29.30)
29.32	[Leah said] "Because YHWH has looked on my affliction; surely now my husband will love me."
34.3	And [Shechem's] essence was drawn to Dinah daughter of Jacob; he loved the girl, and spoke tenderly to her.
37.3	<b>Now Israel loved Joseph more than any other of his children</b> , because he was the son of his old age; and he had made him a long robe with sleeves. (again, 37.4; 44.20)
