<p>If it is YHWH who has incited you [svth] against me...</p>	<p>Again the anger of YHWH was kindled against Israel, and he incited [svth] David against them, saying, "Go, count the people of Israel and Judah." (2 Samuel 24.1)</p> <p>Satan stood up against Israel, and incited [svth] David to count the people of Israel. (1 Chronicles 21.1)</p> <p>Now the serpent was more crafty than any other wild animal that YHWH God had made. He said to the woman, "Did God say, 'You shall not eat from any tree in the garden'?" (Genesis 3.1)</p> <p>The great dragon was thrown down, that ancient serpent, who is called the Devil and Satan, the deceiver of the whole world... (Revelation 12.9)</p>
<p>but if it is mortals [ha'adam], may they be cursed before YHWH,</p>	<p>And to the man [le'adam] he said, "Because you have listened to the voice of your wife, and have eaten of the tree about which I commanded you, 'You shall not eat of it,' cursed is the ground because of you..." (Genesis 3.17)</p>
<p>for they have driven me out [grsh] today from my share in the heritage of YHWH</p>	<p>He drove out [grsh] the man; and at the east of the garden of Eden he placed the cherubim, and a sword flaming and turning to guard the way to the tree of life. (Genesis 3.24)</p>
<p>Now therefore, do not let my blood fall to the ground</p>	<p>And YHWH said, "What have you done? Listen; your brother's blood is crying out to me from the ground!" (Genesis 4.10)</p>
<p>away from the presence of YHWH</p>	<p>Then Cain went away from the presence of YHWH (Genesis 4.16)</p>
