Blue = "world" peace green = interpersonal peace pink = imperial peace

1.79	to give light to those who sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, to guide our feet into <u>the way of peace</u> ."
2.14	"Glory to God in the highest heaven, and <u>on earth peace</u> among those whom he favors!"
2.29	"Master, now you are <u>dismissing your servant in peace</u> , according to your word..."
7.50	he said to the woman, "Your faith has saved you; <u>go in peace</u> ."
8.48	He said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well; <u>go in peace</u> ."
10.5-6	Whatever house you enter, first say, ' Peace <u>to this house!</u> ' And if anyone is there who shares in peace , your peace will rest on that person; but if not, it will return to you.
11.21	When a strong man, fully armed, guards his castle, <u>his property is in peace</u> .
12.51	"Do you think that I have come to <u>bring peace to the earth?</u> No, I tell you, but rather division!"
14.32	"If he cannot, then, while the other is still far away, he sends a delegation and asks for the <u>terms of peace</u> ."
19.38	saying, "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace <u>in heaven</u> , and glory in the highest heaven!"
19.41-42	As he came near and saw the city, he wept over it, saying, "If you, even you, had only recognized on this day <u>the things that make for peace</u> ! But now they are hidden from your eyes."
24.36	While they were talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, " Peace <u>be with you</u> ."
