

## Intratextual links between 1 Samuel 28 and other parts of Samuel

28.3: <b>Now Samuel had died, and all Israel had mourned for him and buried him in Ramah, his own city.</b>	25.1: <b>Now Samuel died; and all Israel assembled and mourned for him. They buried him at his home in Ramah.</b>
28.4: Saul gathered all Israel, and they encamped at <b>Gilboa</b> .	31.1-2: Now the Philistines fought against Israel; and the men of Israel fled before the Philistines, and many fell on Mount <b>Gilboa</b> . The Philistines overtook Saul and his sons; and the Philistines killed Jonathan and Abinadab and Malchishua, the sons of Saul.
28.5: When <b>Saul</b> saw the army of the Philistines, he <b>was afraid</b> , and <b>his heart trembled greatly</b> .	15.24: Saul said to Samuel, "I have sinned; for I have transgressed the commandment of YHWH and your words, because <b>I feared the people</b> and obeyed their voice. 13.7: Saul was still at Gilgal, and <b>all the people followed him trembling</b> . 14.15: There was a panic in the camp, in the field, and among all the people; the garrison and <b>even the raiders trembled</b>
28.7: Then Saul said to his servants, " <b>Seek out for me a woman</b> who is a medium, so that I may go to her and <b>inquire of her</b> ."	9.11: they went up the hill to the town, they <b>met some girls coming out to draw water, and said to them, "Is the seer here?"</b>
28.8a: So <b>Saul disguised himself and put on other clothes</b>	19.13: <b>Michal</b> took a <i>terafim</i> ...and <b>covered it with the clothes</b> . 21.13: So [ <b>David</b> ] <b>changed his behavior</b> before [the Philistines]
28.8b: They came to the woman <b>by night</b> .	3.2: At that time Eli, whose eyesight had begun to grow dim so that he could not see
28.8c: And he said, " <b>Consult [qsm] a spirit</b> for me,	15.23: For rebellion is no less a sin than <b>divination [qsm]</b>
28.9: <b>(The woman does not recognize Saul at first)</b>	9.15-18: <b>(Saul does not recognize Samuel at first)</b>
28.9: [ <b>Saul</b> ] <b>has cut off [tikrit] the mediums and the wizards from the land</b> .	20.15: [David to Jonathan]: <b>never cut off [tikrit] your faithful love from my house</b> , even if YHWH were to cut off every one of the enemies of David from the face of the earth."
28.11: Then the woman said, " <b>Whom shall I bring up for you?</b> " He answered, "Bring up Samuel for me."	2.6: <b>YHWH kills and brings to life; he brings down to Sheol and raises up</b> .
28.12: the woman said to Saul, " <b>Why have you deceived me? You are Saul!</b> "	19.17: Saul said to Michal, " <b>Why have you deceived me</b> like this, and let my enemy [David] go, so that he has escaped?"
28.14: "he is <b>wrapped in a robe</b> ."	2.19: [Samuel's] mother [Hannah] used to make for him <b>a little robe</b> and take it to him each year, when she went up with her husband to offer the yearly sacrifice.
28.14: [ <b>Saul</b> ] <b>bowed with his face to the ground, and did obeisance</b> .	20.41: <b>David</b> rose from beside the stone heap and <b>prostrated himself with his face to the ground</b> .
28.15b" <b>Saul answered, "I am in great distress</b> , for the Philistines are warring against me, and God has turned away from me..."	2.32: Then <b>in distress you [Eli] will look</b> with greedy eye on all the prosperity that shall be bestowed upon Israel; and <b>no one in your family shall ever live to old age</b> .
28.15c: " <b>God has turned away from me and answers me no more</b> , either by prophets or by dreams..."	14.37: So <b>Saul inquired of God</b> , "Shall I go down after the Philistines? Will you give them into the hand of Israel?" <b>But he did not answer him that day</b> .

28.16a: <b>Samuel said, "Why then do you ask [<i>sha'al</i>] me...?"</b>	10.22: So <b>they inquired [<i>sha'al</i>] again of YHWH, "Did the man [Saul] come here?"</b>
28.17b: <b>YHWH has torn the kingdom out of your hand, and given it to your neighbor, David.</b>	15.28: <b>And Samuel said to him, "YHWH has torn the kingdom of Israel from you this very day, and has given it to a neighbor of yours, who is better than you.</b>
28.17-19: <b>threefold prediction of Saul's downfall and death</b>	10.1-8: <b>threefold prediction of Saul's reign</b>
28.18: <b>Because you did not obey the voice of YHWH, and did not carry out his fierce wrath against Amalek, therefore YHWH has done this thing to you today.</b>	15.13-14: When Samuel came to Saul, Saul said to him, "May you be blessed by YHWH; <b>I have carried out the command of YHWH.</b> " But <b>Samuel said, "What then is this bleating of sheep in my ears, and the lowing of cattle that I hear?"</b>
28.19: Moreover YHWH will give Israel along with you into the hands of the Philistines; and <b>tomorrow you and your sons shall be with me;</b> YHWH will also give the army of Israel into the hands of the Philistines."  ( <b>The woman tells Saul his future:</b> that YHWH has rejected him and the Israelites will fall to the Philistine)	9.16: " <b>Tomorrow</b> about this time I will send to you a man from the land of Benjamin, and <b>you shall anoint him to be ruler over my people Israel.</b> 19.11b: David's wife Michal told him, "If you do not save your life tonight, <b>tomorrow you will be killed.</b> " 3.13: I swear to the house of Eli that the iniquity of Eli's house shall not be expiated by sacrifice or offering forever." 25.28-31: ( <b>Abigail tells David his future:</b> that YHWH is with him in leading Israel)
28.20a: Immediately <b>Saul fell full length on the ground</b>	9.2: [ <b>Saul</b> ] <b>stood head and shoulders above everyone else.</b>
28.20b: <b>Saul ... filled with fear</b> because of the words of Samuel	15.24: I have transgressed the commandment of YHWH and your words, because <b>I feared the people and obeyed their voice.</b> 17.11: When <b>Saul and all Israel</b> heard these words of the Philistine, they were dismayed and <b>greatly afraid.</b>
28.21b: "Your servant has listened to you; <b>I have taken my life in my palm,</b> and have listened to what you have said to me.	19.5: " <b>[David] took his life in his palm</b> when he attacked the Philistine...."
28.22b: let me set <b>a morsel of bread</b> before you.	2.36: Everyone who is left in [Eli's] family shall come to implore [the future priest] for a piece of silver or a loaf of bread, and shall say, Please put me in one of the priest's places, that I may eat <b>a morsel of bread.</b> "
28.23a: But his servants, together with the woman, urged him; and <b>he listened to their words.</b>	9.11-14: <b>Saul listens to the words of the girls he meets</b>
28.23b: So he got up from the ground and <b>sat on the bed.</b>	19.13a: Michal took a <b>terafim</b> and laid it <b>on the bed</b>
28.23c: [ <b>Saul</b> ] <b>got up from the ground</b>	2 Samuel 12.20: Then <b>David rose from the ground</b>
28.23d: and [ <b>Saul</b> ] <b>sat on the bed.</b>	19.16: When the messengers came in, <b>the terafim was in the bed,</b> with the covering of goats' hair on its head 2 Sam 4.7: [ <b>Saul's son, Ishbaal</b> ] <b>was lying on his bed</b> in his bedchamber; they attacked him, <b>killed him,</b> and beheaded him.
28.24b: <b>She quickly sacrificed [<i>zvch</i>] it</b>	15.15: the <b>people spared</b> the best of the sheep and the cattle, <b>to sacrifice [<i>zvch</i>] to YHWH your God</b>
