<p>They had attacked Ziklag, burned it down</p>	<p>He burned the house of YHWH, the king's house, and all the houses of Jerusalem; every great house he burned down. (2 Kings 25.9)</p>
<p>and taken captive the women and all who were in it, both small and great; they killed none of them, but</p>	<p>Those of you who escape shall remember me among the nations where they are carried captive (Ezekiel 6.9)</p>
<p>drove them off, and went their way.</p>	<p>YHWH will scatter you among the peoples; only a few of you will be left among the nations where YHWH will drive you. (Deuteronomy 4.27)</p>
<p>David was in great distress...</p>	<p>In your distress, when all these things have happened to you in time to come, you will return to YHWH your God and heed him. (Deuteronomy 4.30)</p>
