

Mamre, Machpelah, Kiriath-arba, Hebron in Genesis

13.18	So Abram moved his tent, and came and settled by the oaks of Mamre , <u>which are at Hebron</u>
23.2	And Sarah died at Kiriath-arba (<u>that is, Hebron</u>) in the land of Canaan
23.19	Abraham buried Sarah his wife in the cave of the field of Machpelah <u>facing Mamre (that is, Hebron)</u> in the land of Canaan.
25.9-10a	His sons Isaac and Ishmael buried him in the cave of Machpelah , in the field of Ephron son of Zohar the Hittite, <u>east of Mamre</u> , the field that Abraham purchased from the Hittites.
35.27	Jacob came to his father Isaac at Mamre , or Kiriath-arba (<u>that is, Hebron</u>), where Abraham and Isaac had resided as aliens.
49.29b-32	"Bury me with my ancestors--in the cave in the field of Ephron the Hittite, in the cave in the field at Machpelah , <u>near Mamre</u> , in the land of Canaan, in the field that Abraham bought from Ephron the Hittite as a burial site. There Abraham and his wife Sarah were buried; there Isaac and his wife Rebekah were buried; and there I buried Leah—the field and the cave that is in it were purchased from the Hittites."
50.13	They carried him to the land of Canaan and buried him in the cave of the field at Machpelah , the field <u>near Mamre</u> , which Abraham bought as a burial site from Ephron the Hittite.

Paddan-aram, Aram-naharaim, Haran in Genesis

11.32	The days of Terah were two hundred five years; and <u>Terah died in Haran</u> .
12.5	Abram took his wife Sarai and his brother's son Lot, and <u>all the possessions that they had gathered, and the persons whom they had acquired in Haran</u> ; and they set forth to go to the land of Canaan.
24.10	[Abraham's servant] set out and went to Aram-naharaim , <u>to the city of Nahor</u> .
25.20	Isaac was forty years old when he married Rebekah, <u>daughter of Bethuel the Aramean of Paddan-aram, sister of Laban the Aramean</u> .
27.43b	flee at once to <u>my brother Laban in Haran</u>
28.2	Go at once to Paddan-aram <u>to the house of Bethuel</u> , your mother's father; and take as wife from there one of the daughters of Laban, your mother's brother.
28.5	Thus Isaac sent Jacob away; and he went to Paddan-aram , <u>to Laban son of Bethuel the Aramean, the brother of Rebekah, Jacob's and Esau's mother</u> .
31.18	[Jacob] drove away all his livestock, all the property that he had gained, the livestock in his possession that <u>he had acquired in Paddan-aram</u> , to go to his father Isaac in the land of Canaan.
33.18	Jacob came safely to the city of Shechem, which is in the land of Canaan, <u>on his way from Paddan-aram</u>
35.9	God appeared to Jacob again when <u>he came from Paddan-aram</u> , and he blessed him.
35.26b	These were the sons of Jacob who were <u>born to him in Paddan-aram</u> .
46.15	(these are the sons of Leah, whom <u>she bore to Jacob in Paddan-aram</u>
