Rebekah's lineage in Genesis

11.27-29

Now these are the descendants of Terah. **Terah was the father of Abram, Nahor, and Haran;** and Haran was the father of Lot. Haran died before his father Terah in the land of his birth, in Ur of the Chaldeans. Abram and **Nahor** took women; the name of Abram's woman was Sarai, and the **name of Nahor's woman was Milcah**. She was the **daughter of Haran the father of Milcah and Iscah**.

22.20-23

Now after these things it was told Abraham, "Milcah also has borne children, to your brother Nahor: Uz the firstborn, Buz his brother, Kemuel the father of Aram, Chesed, Hazo, Pildash, Jidlaph, and Bethuel." Bethuel became the father of Rebekah. These eight Milcah bore to Nahor, Abraham's brother.

Rebekah, who was **born to Bethuel son of Milcah**, **the woman of Nahor**, Abraham's brother

24.24

She said to him, "I am the daughter of Bethuel son of Milcah, whom she bore to Nahor."

24.47

Then I asked her, 'Whose daughter are you?' She said, 'The daughter of Bethuel, Nahor's son, whom Milcah bore to him.'

25.20

Isaac was forty years old when he married **Rebekah**, daughter of **Bethuel the Aramean** of **Paddan-aram**, sister of Laban the Aramean.

28.2, 5

Go at once to Paddan-aram to the house of Bethuel, your mother's father; and take as woman from there one of the daughters of Laban, your mother's brother....Thus Isaac sent Jacob away; and he went to Paddan-aram, to Laban son of Bethuel the Aramean, the brother of Rebekah, Jacob's and Esau's mother.
