

Rebekah's lineage in Genesis

11.27-29

Now these are the descendants of Terah. **Terah was the father of Abram, Nahor, and Haran;** and Haran was the father of Lot. Haran died before his father Terah in the land of his birth, in Ur of the Chaldeans. Abram and **Nahor** took women; the name of Abram's woman was Sarai, and the **name of Nahor's woman was Milcah.** She was the **daughter of Haran the father of Milcah and Iscah.**

22.20-23

Now after these things it was told Abraham, "**Milcah also has borne children, to your brother Nahor:** Uz the firstborn, Buz his brother, Kemuel the father of Aram, Chesed, Hazo, Pildash, Jidlaph, **and Bethuel.**" **Bethuel became the father of Rebekah.** These eight **Milcah** bore to **Nahor,** Abraham's brother.

Q: Where's Laban, Rebekah's brother, in this list?

24.15

Rebekah, who was **born to Bethuel son of Milcah,** the woman of **Nahor,** Abraham's brother

24.24

She said to him, "**I am the daughter of Bethuel son of Milcah,** whom she bore to **Nahor.**"

24.47

Then I asked her, 'Whose daughter are you?' She said, '**The daughter of Bethuel, Nahor's son, whom Milcah bore to him.**'

25.20

Isaac was forty years old when he married **Rebekah,** daughter of **Bethuel** the Aramean of **Paddan-aram, sister of Laban** the Aramean.

28.2, 5

Go at once to Paddan-aram to the **house of Bethuel, your mother's father;** and **take as woman from there one of the daughters of Laban, your mother's brother....** Thus Isaac sent Jacob away; and he went to Paddan-aram, **to Laban son of Bethuel** the Aramean, the brother of **Rebekah,** Jacob's and Esau's mother.
