

“Cause/make to sit/recline [at table]” (*kataklinō*) in Luke

One of the Pharisees asked Jesus to eat with him, and he went into the Pharisee's house and **took his place at the table.** (7.36)

For there were about five thousand men. And he said to his disciples, "**Make them sit down** in groups of about fifty each." (9.14)

"When you are invited by someone to a wedding banquet, **do not sit down** at the place of honor, in case someone more distinguished than you has been invited by your host... (14.8)

When he was at the table with [the disciples], he took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them. (24.30)
