1.71	that <u>we would be saved from</u> our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us.
6.22	" <u>Blessed are you when</u> people hate you , and when they exclude you, revile you, and defame you on account of the Human One."
6.27	"But I say to you that listen, Love your enemies, <u>do good to</u> those who hate you"
14.26	"Whoever comes to me and does not hate father and mother , wife and children , brothers and sisters , yes , and even life itself , <u>cannot be my disciple</u> ."
