

“Life” (*psuchē*) in Luke [translations from NRSV]

1.46-47	And Mary said, "My soul <u>magnifies the Lord</u> , and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior..."
2.35	the inner thoughts of many will be revealed--and <u>a sword will pierce your own soul too.</u> "
6.9	Then Jesus said to them, "I ask you, is it lawful to do good or to do harm on the sabbath, <u>to save life or to destroy it?</u> "
9.24	"For those who want to <u>save their life will lose it</u> , and those who <u>lose their life for my sake will save it.</u> "
10.27	He answered, "You shall <u>love the Lord your God</u> with all your heart, and <u>with all your soul</u> , and with all your strength, and with all your mind; and your neighbor as yourself."
12.19-20	And I will say to my soul , ' Soul , <u>you have ample goods</u> laid up for many years; relax, eat, drink, be merry.' But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life <u>is being demanded of you</u> . And the things you have prepared, whose will they be?'
14.26	"Whoever comes to me and <u>does not hate</u> father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and even life itself, <u>cannot be my disci- ple.</u> "
17.33	"Those who <u>try to make their life secure will lose it</u> , but those who lose their life will keep it."
21.19	<u>By your endurance [<i>hupomenē</i>, "faithful resistance"] you will gain your souls.</u>
