D: 28:10-22: encounter (paya`) with divine at sacred site, near border, berakhah

E: ch. 29: internal cycle opens; arrival; Laban at border; deception, wages

F: 30:1-24: Rachel barren, then fertile

F1: 30:25-43: Jacob exploits fertility of sheep

E¹: ch. 31: internal cycle closes; departure; Laban at border; deception, wages

D¹: ch. 32: encounter (paya`) with divine at sacred site, near border, berakhah

C¹: ch. 33: deception planned; fear of Esau; berakhah-gift returned; return from land

B¹: ch. 34: interlude; strife, deception, berakhah-gift; covenant with foreigner

A¹: 35:1-22: oracle fulfilled; Rachel struggles in childbirth, *berakhah*; death, resolutions
