Parallels between Genesis 26.34-28.9 and 1 Kings 1

PARALLELS IN CHARACTERS

Isaac = David: the father passing on "blessing"/reign

Esau = Adonijah, the "elder" son who reaches out to claim the prize

Rebekah = Bathsheba: the mother of the "other" son who seeks to manipulate the "father" to choose "her" son

Jacob = Solomon: the "other" son who ends up with the prize

PARALLELS IN PLOT

Isaac and David are both "old" and there is an implicit question of their mental acuity

Uncertainly in readers over whether the "father" (Isaac/David) are sure which son they are choosing

Edom is an "adversary" (1 Kgs 11.14ff) to Solomon as Esau is to Jacob

Esau hunted game, while Adonijah sacrificed oxen, cattle and sheep
