3.14	" Do not extort money from anyone by threats or false accusation, and be satisfied with your wages."
7.41	certain creditor had two <u>debtors</u> ; one <u>owed</u> five hundred denarii , and the other fifty .
9.3	"Take nothing for your journey, no staff, nor bag, nor bread, nor money -- not even an extra tunic.
9.13	But he said to them, "You give them something to eat." They said, "We have no more than five loaves and two fish-- unless we are to go and buy food for all these people."
10.35	The next day he took out two denarii , <u>gave them to the innkeeper</u> , and said, 'Take care of him; and when I come back, I will repay you whatever more you spend.'
14.18-19	The first said to him, ' I have bought a piece of land , and I must go out and see it; please accept my regrets.' Another said, ' I have bought five yoke of oxen...
15.8-9	"Or what woman having ten silver coins (drachmas) , if she <u>loses one</u> of them, does not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds it? When she has found it, she calls together her friends and neighbors, saying, 'Rejoice with me, for I have found the coin that I had lost.'
16.14	The <u>Pharisees</u> , who were lovers of money , heard all this, and they ridiculed him.
17.28	Likewise, just as it was in the days of Lot: they were eating and drinking, buying and selling , planting and building,
18.22	Sell all that you own and distribute the money to the poor , and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me."
19.12-25	[Story of the nobleman who gives " pounds " (<i>nmas</i>) <u>to ten slaves</u> to make more]
20.24	" Show me a denarius . Whose head and whose title does it bear?" They said, "The emperor's."
21.2	he also saw a poor widow put in two small copper coins (lepta) .
22.5	They were greatly pleased and agreed to give [Judas] money .
22.36	And the one who has no sword must sell his cloak and buy one .
