Hebrew, <u>zagen</u>, "elder," is found 180 times in the Masoretic Text. The phrase "elders of Israel" is found 31 times in the Hebrew Scriptures and once in the New Testament. The use is distributed as follows:

All the people of Israel assembled to King Solomon at the festival in the month Ethanim, which is the seventh month. And all the elders of Israel came, and the priests carried the ark.
