

## Entos in the Septuagint

...my heart became hot *within* me. (Psalm 39.3; LXX, 38.4)

Therefore my insides moan like a lyre for Moab, and my *innermost being* for Kir-hareseth. (Isaiah 16.11)

My lord, due to the vision anguish has come upon me, and I have retained no strength. (Daniel 10.16)

They also rebuilt the sanctuary and the *interior* of the temple, and consecrated the courts. (1 Maccabees 4.48)

There is a rascal bowed down in mourning, but *inwardly* he is full of deceit. (Sirach 19.26)
