Entos in the Septuagint

...my heart became hot within me. (Psalm 39.3; LXX, 38.4)

Bless YHWH, O my life; and <u>all that is within me</u>, bless his holy name! (Ps 103.1; LXX, 102.1)

For I am poor and needy, and <u>my heart is stricken within me</u>. (Psalm 109.22 (LXX, 108.22)

He made its posts of silver, its back of gold, its seat of purple; <u>its interior</u> was inlaid with love. (Song 3.1)

Therefore my insides moan like a lyre for Moab, and my innermost being for Kirhareseth. (Isaiah 16.11)

My lord, due to the vision <u>anguish has come upon me</u>, and I have retained no strength. (Daniel 10.16)

They also rebuilt the sanctuary and the <u>interior of the temple</u>, and consecrated the courts. (1 Maccabees 4.48)

There is a rascal bowed down in mourning, but <u>inwardly</u> he is full of deceit. (Sirach 19.26)
