## Chesed (faithfulness, covenant loyalty, divine kindness, steadfast love) in Samuel

1 SAMUEL	
15.6	<u>Saul said to the Kenites</u> , "Go! Leave! Withdraw from among the Amalekites, or I will destroy you with them; for <u>you showed</u> <b>kindness</b> to all the people of Israel when they came up out of Egypt."
20.8, 14- 15	[David to Jonathan]: Therefore <b>deal kindly</b> with your servant, for you have brought your servant into a sacred covenant with you."
	[Jonathan to David]: If I am still alive, show me the faithful love of YHWH;but if I die, never cut off your faithful love from my house, even if YHWH were to cut off every one of the enemies of David from the face of the earth."
2 SAMUEL	
2.5-6	<u>David sent messengers to the people of Jabesh-gilead</u> , and said to them, "May you be blessed by YHWH, because <u>you showed this</u> <b>loyalty</b> to Saul your lord, and buried him! Now <u>may YHWH show</u> <b>steadfast love</b> and faithfulness to you! And I too will reward you because you have done this thing.
3.8	The words of Ishbaal made Abner very angry; he said, "Am I a dog's head for Judah? Today I keep showing loyalty to the house of your father Saul, to his brothers, and to his friends, and have not given you into the hand of David; and yet you charge me now with a crime concerning this woman."
7.14-15	[YHWH to David via Nathan]: "I will be a father to him, and he shall be a son to me. When he commits iniquity, I will punish him with a rod such as mortals use, with blows inflicted by human beings. But I will not take my <b>steadfast love</b> from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away from before you."
9.1. 3. 7	<u>David asked</u> , "Is there still anyone left of the house of Saul to whom I may show kindness for Jonathan's sake? The king said, "Is there anyone remaining of the house of Saul to whom I may show the kindness of God?" Ziba said to the king, "There remains a son of Jonathan; he is crippled in his feet." David said to him, "Do not be afraid, for I will show you kindness for the sake of your father Jonathan; I will restore to you all the land of your grandfather Saul, and you yourself shall eat at my table always."
10.2	<u>David said</u> , " <b>I will deal loyally</b> with <u>Hanun son of Nahash, just as his father <b>dealt loyally</b> with me." So David sent envoys to console him concerning his father.</u>
15.20	[David to Ittai the Gittite]: "You came only yesterday, and shall I today make you wander about with us, while I go wherever I can? Go back, and take your kinsfolk with you; and may YHWH show steadfast love and faithfulness to you."
16.17	Absalom said to Hushai, " <u>Is this your <b>loyalty</b> to your friend?</u> Why did you not go with your friend?"
22.51	[YHWH] is a tower of salvation for his king, <u>and shows <b>steadfast love</b> to his anointed, to David and his descendants forever.</u>
