Amos 7.12-13	And Amaziah said to Amos, "O seer, go, flee away to the land of Judah, earn your bread there, and prophesy there; but <u>never again prophesy at Bethel, for it is the king's sanctuary, and it is a temple of the kingdom."</u>
Amos 3.14	On the day I punish Israel for its transgressions, <u>I will punish the altars of Bethel</u> , and the horns of the altar shall be cut off and fall to the ground.
Jeremiah 48.13	Then Moab shall be ashamed of Chemosh, as the <u>house of Israel was ashamed of Beth-el</u> , their confidence.
2 Kins 23.15	Moreover, the altar at Bethel , the high place erected by Jeroboam son of Nebat, who caused Israel to sinhe pulled down that altar along with the high place. He <u>burned the high place</u> , crushing it to dust; he also burned the sacred pole.
2 Kings 23.4	The king [Josiah] commanded the high priest Hilkiah, the priests of the second order, and the guardians of the threshold, to <u>bring out of the temple of YHWH all the vessels made for Baal, for Asherah</u> , and for all the host of heaven; he burned them outside Jerusalem in the fields of the Kidron, and <u>carried their ashes to Bethel</u> .
2 Kings 2.2	Elijah said to Elisha , "Stay here; for <u>YHWH has sent me as far as Bethel."</u> But Elisha said, "As YHWH lives, and as you yourself live, I will not leave you." So they went down to Bethel .
1 Kings 12.28- 30	So [Jeroboam] took counsel, and <u>made two calves of gold</u> . He said to the people, "You have gone up to Jerusalem long enough. Here are your gods, Oisrael, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt." <u>He set one in Bethel</u> , and the other he put in <u>Dan</u> . And this thing became a sin, for the people went to worship before the one at Bethel and before the other as far as <u>Dan</u> .
1 Samuel 7.16	[Samuel] went on a circuit year by year to Bethel , Gilgal, and Mizpah; and he judged Israel in all these places.
Examples beyond Genesis [green = positive pink = negative]	
35.15-16a:	"So Jacob called the place where God had spoken with him Bethel . Then they journeyed from Bethel "
35.6-8:	Jacob came to Luz (that is, Bethel), which is in the land of Canaan, he and all the people who were with him, and there he built an altar and <u>called the place El-Bethel, because it was there that God had revealed himself to him when he fled from his brother</u> . And Deborah, Rebekah's nurse, died, and she was buried under an oak below Bethel .
35.2-3:	So Jacob said to his household and to all who were with him, "Put away the foreign gods that are among you, and purify yourselves, and change your clothes; then come, <u>let us</u> go up to Bethel , that I may make an altar there to the God who answered me in the day of my distress and has been with me wherever I have gone."
35.1:	God said to Jacob, "Arise, go up to Bethel , and settle there. Make an altar there to the God who appeared to you when you fled from your brother Esau."
31.13:	<u>"I am the God of Bethel</u> , where you anointed a pillar and made a vow to me. Now leave this land at once and return to the land of your birth."
28.18-19:	"So Jacob rose early in the morning, and he took the stone that he had put under his head and set it up for a pillar and poured oil on the top of it. He called that place Bethel ; but the name of the city was Luz at the first." (Bethel/Luz : Joshua 16.1-2; 18.13; Judges 1.22-23)
134:	"He journeyed on by stages from the Negeb as far as Bethel , to the place <u>where his tent</u> <u>had been at the beginning</u> , between Bethel and Ai, to the place where he had made an altar at the first; and there Abram called on the name of YHWH."
12.8:	"From there [Abram' moved on to the hill country on the east of Bethel , <u>and pitched his</u> <u>tent</u> , with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east; and there he built an altar to YHWH and invoked the name of YHWH.
