

“David” in Luke

1.27	a virgin engaged to a man whose name was Joseph, of the <u>house of David</u> . The virgin's name was Mary.
1.32	He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give to him the <u>throne of his father David</u> .
2.4	Joseph also went from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to <u>the city of David called Bethlehem</u> , because he was descended from <u>the house and family of David</u> .
2.11	to you is born this day in <u>the city of David</u> a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord.
3.31	...son of Melea, son of Menna, son of Mattatha, son of Nathan, <u>son of David</u> ,...
6.3	Jesus answered, "Have you not read <u>what David did</u> when he and his companions were hungry?"
18.38-39	Then he shouted, " <u>Jesus, Son of David</u> , have mercy on me!" Those who were in front sternly ordered him to be quiet; but he shouted even more loudly, " <u>Son of David</u> , have mercy on me!"
20.41-44	Then he said to them, "How can they say that the Messiah is <u>David's son</u> ? For <u>David himself says</u> in the book of Psalms, 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, until I make your enemies your footstool.'" <u>David thus calls him Lord</u> ; so how can he be his son?"
