6.42	"Or how can you say to your neighbor, 'Friend, let me cast out the speck in your eye,' when you yourself do not see the log in your own eye? You hypocrite, first cast out the log out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to cast out the speck out of your neighbor's eye."
