

## “Fig” trees in Luke and the New Testament

### Three named trees in Luke:



**“fig tree” (*sukē*):** the ordinary fig tree with sweet fruit, found in many varieties in the Middle East:

Luke 13.6-7; 21

Mark 11.13-21; 13.28

Matthew 21.19-21; 24.32

John 1.48-50

James 3.12

Revelation 6.13



**“fig-mulberry tree” (*sukaminō*):**

only Luke 17.6 in New Testament



**“sycamore tree” (*sukomorean*):**

only Luke 19.4 in Greek Bible
