"Fig" trees in Luke and the New Testament

Three named trees in Luke:



"fig tree" (sukē): the ordinary fig tree with sweet fruit, found in many varieties in the Middle East:
Luke 13.6-7; 21
Mark 11.13-21; 13.28
Matthew 21.19-21; 24.32
John 1.48-50
James 3.12
Revelation 6.13



"fig-mulberry tree" (*sukaminō***):** only Luke 17.6 in New Testament



"sycamore tree" (sukomorean): only Luke 19.4 in Greek Bible
