

## “Named” [Greek, *onoma*] characters in Luke

1.5	In the days of King Herod of Judea, there was a <b>priest named Zechariah</b> , who belonged to the priestly order of Abijah. His wife was a descendant of Aaron, and <b>her name was Elizabeth</b> .
1.13	Your wife Elizabeth will bear you a son, and <b>you will name him John</b> .
1.27	The <b>virgin's name was Mary</b> .
1.31	And now, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and <b>you will name him Jesus</b> .
1.49	the Mighty One has done great things for me, and <b>holy is his name</b> . [also, 11.2]
1.59-63	[Ending with:] " <b>His name is John</b> ."
2.21	<b>he was named Jesus</b> , the name given by the angel before he was conceived in the womb.
2.25	Now there was a man in Jerusalem whose <b>name was Simeon</b> ; this man was righteous and devout, looking forward to the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit rested on him.
5.27	After this he went out and saw a <b>tax collector named Levi</b> , sitting at the tax booth; and he said to him, "Follow me."
8.30	Jesus then asked him, " <b>What is your name?</b> " He said, " <b>Legion</b> "; for many demons had entered him.
8.41	Just then there came a <b>man named Jairus, a leader of the synagogue</b> .
10.38	Now as they went on their way, he entered a certain village, where <b>a woman named Martha</b> welcomed him into her home.
16.20	And at his gate lay <b>a poor man named Lazarus</b> , covered with sores...
19.2	<b>A man was there named Zacchaeus</b> ; he was a chief tax collector and was rich.
23.50-51a	Now there was <b>a good and righteous man named Joseph</b> , who, though a member of the council, had not agreed to their plan and action.
24.18	Then one of them, <b>whose name was Cleopas</b> ...
