28.11	He came to a certain place and stayed there for the <b>night</b> , because the sun had set.
28.12	And <b>he dreamed</b> that there was a <i>sullam</i> set up on the earth, the top of it reaching to heaven; and the angels of God were ascending and descending on it.
30.16	When Jacob came from the field in the evening, Leah went out to meet him, and said, "You must come in to me; for I have hired you with my son's mandrakes." So he lay with her that <b>night</b> .
31.10ff	"During the mating of the flock I once had <b>a dream</b> in which I looked up and saw that the male goats that leaped upon the flock were striped, speckled, and mottled."
31.24	But God came to Laban the Aramean in <b>a dream by night</b> , and said to him, "Take heed that you say not a word to Jacob, either good or bad."
