2.4	Joseph also went from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to the city of David called Bethlehem
2.11	you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Messiah, the Lord.
7.37	And a woman in the city , who was a sinner, having learned that he was eating in the Pharisee's house, brought an alabaster jar of ointment.
8.27	As he stepped out on land, a man of the city who had demons met him.
8.34	When the swineherds saw what had happened, they ran off and told it in the city and in the country.
8.39	"Return to your home, and declare how much God has done for you." So he went away, proclaiming throughout the city how much Jesus had done for him.
13.34	"Jerusalem, Jerusalem, the city that kills the prophets and stones those who are sent to it! How often have I desired to gather your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings, and you were not willing!"
