

1 SAMUEL 19.13-18

Michal took a teraphim and laid it on the bed; she put a net of goats' hair on its head, and covered it with the clothes [as Rachel covers the teraphim with the saddle and her body]. When Saul sent messengers to take David, she said, "He is sick." Then Saul sent the messengers to see David for themselves. He said, "Bring him up to me in the bed, that I may kill him." When the messengers came in, the teraphim was in the bed, with the covering of goats' hair on its head. Saul said to Michal, **"Why have you deceived me like this [as Laban asks Jacob],** and let my enemy go, so that he has escaped?" **Michal answered Saul, "He said to me, 'Let me go; why should I kill you?'" [As Rachel gives a deceiving answer to her father.]** **Now David fled and escaped [as Jacob will];** he came to Samuel at Ramah, and told him all that Saul had done to him. He and Samuel went and settled at Nai-oth.
