2 Samuel 6.1-5: echoes from 1 Samuel 4.1-7.2

David again gathered all the chosen men **of Israel**, **thirty thousand**. So the Philistines fought; Israel was defeated, and they fled, everyone to his home. There was a very great slaughter, for there fell **of Israel thirty thousand** foot soldiers. (1 Samuel 4.10)

David and all the people with him set out and went from Baale-judah, to bring up from there the ark of God, which is called by the name of **YHWH of hosts who is enthroned on the cherubim.**

So the people sent to Shiloh, and brought from there the ark of the covenant of **YHWH of hosts, who is enthroned on the cherubim**. (1 Samuel 4.4)

They carried the ark of God on **a new cart**, and brought it out of the house of Abinadab, which was on the hill.

Now then, get ready **a new cart** and two milch cows that have never borne a yoke, and yoke the cows to the cart, but take their calves home, away from them. (1 Samuel 6.7)

Uzzah and Ahio, the sons of Abinadab, were driving the new cart with the ark of God; and Ahio went in front of the ark.

The ark of God was captured; and the **two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas**, died. (1 Samuel 4.11)

David and all the house of Israel **were dancing before YHWH** with all their might, with songs and lyres and harps and tambourines and castanets and cymbals. all the house of Israel **lamented after YHWH**. (1 Samuel 7.2)
