When Rachel had borne Joseph, Jacob said to Laban, "Send me away, that I may go to my own place and land. **Give** me my women and my children for whom I have served you, and let me go; for you know very well the service I have given you." But Laban said to him, "If you will allow me to say so, I have learned by divination that YHWH has blessed me because of you; name your wages, and I will give it." Jacob said to him, "You yourself know how I have served you, and what your cattle have become with me. For you had little before I faced you, and it has increased abundantly; and YHWH has blessed you wherever I turned. But now when shall I provide for my own household also?" He said, "What shall I give you?" Jacob said, "You shall not give me anything; if you will do this for me, I will again feed your flock and keep it: let me pass through all your flock today, removing from it every <u>speckled</u> and <u>spot-</u> ted sheep and every <u>black</u> lamb, and the <u>spotted</u> and <u>speckled</u> among the goats; and such shall be my wages. So my honesty will answer for me later, when you come to face into my wages with you. Every one that is not <u>speckled</u> and <u>spotted</u> among the goats and <u>black</u> among the lambs, if found with me, shall be counted stolen." Laban said, "Good! Let it be as you have said."

But that day **Laban** removed the male goats that were **striped** and **spotted**, and all the female goats that were **speckled** and **spotted**, every one that had **white** on it, and every lamb that was **black**, and **gave** them to his sons; and he set a distance of three days' journey between himself and Jacob, while Jacob was pasturing the rest of **Laban's** flock. Then Jacob took fresh rods of **poplar** and <u>almond</u> and plane, and peeled white streaks in them, exposing the **white** of the rods. He set the rods that he had peeled in front of the flocks in the <u>troughs</u>, that is, the watering places, where the flocks came to drink. And since they **bred** when they came to drink, the flocks bred in front of the rods, and so the flocks produced young that were **striped**, **speckled**, and **spotted**. Jacob separated the lambs, and **gave** the faces of the **flocks** toward the **striped** and the completely **black** animals in the **flock** of **Laban**; and he put his own droves apart, and did not put them with **Laban's** flock. Whenever the stronger of the **flock** were **breeding**, Jacob laid the **rods** in the troughs before the eyes of the **flocks**, that they might **breed** among the **rods**, but for the <u>feebler</u> of the **flock** he did not lay them there; so the <u>feebler</u> were **Laban's**, and the stronger Jacob's. Thus the man grew exceedingly rich, and had large **flocks**, and male and female slaves, and camels and donkeys.

Now Jacob heard that the sons of Laban were saying, "Jacob has taken all that was our father's; he has gained all this glory from what belonged to our father." And Jacob saw that behold, Laban's face was not there with him as yesterday. Then YHWH said to Jacob, "Return to the land of your ancestors and to your kindred, and I will be with you."

So Jacob sent and called Rachel and Leah into the field where his flock was, and said to them, "I see that your father's face is not toward me as it was yesterday and the day before. But the God of my father has been with me. You know that I have served your father with all my strength; yet your father has cheated me and changed my wages ten times, but God did not give him to harm me. If he said, 'The speckled shall be your wages,' then all the flock bore speckled; and if he said, 'The striped shall be your wages,' then all the flock bore striped. Thus God has taken away the livestock of your father, and given them to me. During the breeding of the flock I lifted my eyes and saw, a dream, behold, and saw that the male goats that leaped upon the **flock** were **striped**, **speckled**, and <u>mottled</u>. Then the angel of God said to me in the dream, 'Jacob,' and I said, 'Here I am!' And he said, 'Raise, please, your eyes and see that all the goats that leap on the flock are striped, speckled, and mottled; for I have seen all that Laban is doing to you. I am the God of Bethel, where you anointed a pillar and made a vow to me. Now stand up and come out of this land and return to the land of your birth." Then Rachel and Leah answered him, "Is there any portion or inheritance left to us in our father's house? Are we not regarded by him as foreigners? For he has sold us, and he has eaten up the silver given for us. All the property that God has taken away from our father belongs to us and to our children; now then, do whatever God has said to you."

So Jacob arose, and set his children and his women on camels; and he drove away all his gathered livestock, all the property that he had gathered, the livestock in his possession that he had gathered in Paddan-aram, to go to his father Isaac in the land of Canaan.
