2.32	"a light for revelation to the <b>Gentiles</b> and for glory to your people Israel."
7.5	"for [the centurion] loves our <b>nation</b> , and it is he who built our syna- gogue for us."
12.30	For it is the <b>nations</b> of the world that strive after all these things [i.e., what you are to eat and drink], and your Father knows that you need them.
18.32	"For he will be handed over to the <b>Gentiles</b> ; and he will be mocked and insulted and spat upon."
21.10	Then he said to them, " <b>Nation</b> will rise against <b>nation</b> , and kingdom against kingdom"
