Some factors that make Luke's version of Jesus' Jerusalem ministry unique

- 1. The focus on Jerusalem throughout: 31 of 55 mentions in the Gospels are in Luke plus 60 times in Acts (thus, of 142 times in the New Testament, 91 are in Luke/Acts)
- 2. The presence of Jerusalem and the Temple from the beginning, with young Jesus there among the teachers.
- 3. The "Travel Narrative" from Luke 9-19 that puts the focus on the eventual arrival in Jerusalem
- 4. Jesus' final call: to proclaim *metanoia* and forgiveness in Jesus' Name, starting from Jerusalem (Luke 24.47)
- 5. Acts of the Apostles: Jerusalem as the starting point and home base for the apostolic mission
- 6. Acts of the Apostles: the bringing of Saul/Paul before Judean and Roman leaders in Jerusalem (Acts 25-26)
