

Parallels between 1 Samuel 20 and 2 Samuel 9 (Tushima 2012)

1. Order to go fetch someone (20.31)
2. Reference to Saul's "fields" (20.5, 11, 24, 35)
3. Eating daily at the king's table (20.18-19)
4. Referring to oneself as the servant of one's interlocutor (20.7, 8)
5. Reference to *chesed* (20.8, 14, 15; as three times in 2 Sam 9)
6. Reference to God (20.3, 8, 14, 21-22)
7. Falling on face and doing obeisance (20.41)
