

“Peter and John” in Luke-Acts

IN MARK, Peter and John are only together for the healing of Jairus’ daughter (Mark 5.37, as Luke 8.51), the Transfiguration (Mark 9.2, as Luke 9.28) the apocalyptic discourse (Mark 13.3) and Jesus’ prayer (Mark 14.33) always with James.

IN MATTHEW, they are only together for the Transfiguration (Matthew 17), also with James.

IN JOHN, they are never named together

Luke 22.8	So Jesus sent Peter and John , saying, " Go and prepare the Passover meal for us that we may eat it."
Acts 3.1-4.23	One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the hour of prayer , at three o'clock in the afternoon. [A long story follows with them at the center.]
Acts 8.14-17	Now when the apostles at Jerusalem heard that Samaria had accepted the word of God, they sent Peter and John to them . The two went down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit (for as yet the Spirit had not come upon any of them; they had only been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus). Then Peter and John laid their hands on them, and they received the Holy Spirit.
