

City/cities (Heb, `iy) in Genesis

4.17	Cain knew his woman, and she conceived and bore Enoch; and he built a city , and named it Enoch after his son Enoch .
10.12	Resen between Nineveh and Calah; that is the great city .
11.4-8	Then they said, "Come, let us build ourselves a city , and a tower with its top in the heavens, and let us make a name for ourselves; otherwise we shall be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth." YHWH came down to see the city and the tower, which mortals had built. And YHWH said, "Look, they are one people, and they have all one language; and this is only the beginning of what they will do; nothing that they propose to do will now be impossible for them. Come, let us go down, and confuse their language there, so that they will not understand one another's speech." So YHWH scattered them abroad from there over the face of all the earth, and they left off building the city .
13.12	Abram settled in the land of Canaan, while Lot settled among the cities of the Plain and moved his tent as far as Sodom.
18.24-28	Suppose there are fifty righteous within the city ; will you then sweep away the place and not forgive it for the fifty righteous who are in it? Far be it from you to do such a thing, to slay the righteous with the wicked, so that the righteous fare as the wicked! Far be that from you! Shall not the Judge of all the earth do what is just?" And YHWH said, "If I find at Sodom fifty righteous in the city , I will forgive the whole place for their sake." Abraham answered, "Let me take it upon myself to speak to YHWH, I who am but dust and ashes. Suppose five of the fifty righteous are lacking? Will you destroy the whole city for lack of five?" And he said, "I will not destroy it if I find forty-five there."
19.4-29	[twelve times in the Sodom story]
23.17-18	So the field of Ephron in Machpelah, which was to the east of Mamre, the field with the cave that was in it and all the trees that were in the field, throughout its whole area, passed to Abraham as a possession in the presence of the Hittites , in the presence of all who went in at the gate of his city .
24.10-13	Then the servant took ten of his master's camels and departed, taking all kinds of choice gifts from his master; and he set out and went to Aram-naharaim, to the city of Nahor. He made the camels kneel down outside the city by the well of water; it was toward evening, the time when women go out to draw water. And he said, "O YHWH, God of my master Abraham, please grant me success today and show steadfast love to my master Abraham. I am standing here by the spring of water, and the daughters of the men of the city are coming out to draw water.
26.33	[Isaac] called it Shibah ; therefore the name of the city is Beer-sheba to this day.
28.19	[Jacob] called that place Bethel ; but the name of the city was Luz at the first.
33.18	Jacob came safely to the city of Shechem , which is in the land of Canaan, on his way from Paddan-aram; and he camped before the city .
34.20	So Hamor and his son Shechem came to the gate of their city and spoke to the men of their city [7x in 34.20-28]
35.5	As they journeyed, a terror from God fell upon the cities all around them, so that no one pursued them.
36.32	Bela son of Beor reigned in Edom, the name of his city being Dinhabah . [also, 36.35, 39]
41.35	"Let them gather all the food of these good years that are coming, and lay up grain under the authority of Pharaoh for food in the cities , and let them keep it."
41.48	He gathered up all the food of the seven years when there was plenty in the land of Egypt, and stored up food in the cities ; he stored up in every city the food from the fields around it.
44.4, 13	When they had gone only a short distance from the city , Joseph said to his steward, "Go, follow after the men; and when you overtake them, say to them, 'Why have you returned evil for good? Why have you stolen my silver cup?'... Then each one loaded his donkey, and they returned to the city .
47.21	As for the people, he moved them to the cities from one end of Egypt's border to the other end.
