

Mocking Jesus in Luke's Passion

18.32	For he will be handed over to the nations; and he will be mocked [<i>empaizō</i>] and insulted [<i>hubrizō</i>] and spat upon.
22.63	Now <u>the men who were holding Jesus</u> began to mock [<i>empaizō</i>] him and beat him
22.65	<u>They</u> kept heaping many other insults [<i>blasphēmeō</i>] on him.
23.11	Even <u>Herod with his soldiers</u> treated him with contempt and mocked [<i>empaizō</i>] him
23.35	And the people stood by, watching; but the <u>leaders</u> scoffed [<i>ekmuktērizō</i> ; cf. 16.14] at him, saying, "He saved others; let him save himself if he is the Messiah of God, his chosen one!"
23.36	The <u>soldiers</u> also mocked [<i>empaizō</i>] him, coming up and offering him sour wine
23.39	<u>One of the criminals</u> who were hanged there kept insulting [<i>blasphēmeō</i>] him and saying, "Are you not the Messiah? Save yourself and us!"
