Parallels between Abram's and Jacob's journeys from Shechem to Bethel

12.6-8

- 6 **Abram** passed through the land to the place **at Shechem**, to the **oak of Moreh**. At that time the **Canaanites** were in the land.
- 7 Then YHWH appeared to Abram, and said, "To your offspring I will give this land." So he built there an altar to YHWH, who had appeared to him.
- 8 From there he moved on to the hill country on the east of Bethel, and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east; and there he built an altar to YHWH and invoked the name of YHWH.

33.18-20; 35.1, 4, 6-7

- 18 **Jacob** came safely to the **city of Shechem**, which is in the **land of Canaan**, on his way from Paddan-aram; and he camped before the city.
- 19 And from the sons of Hamor, Shechem's father, he bought for one hundred pieces of money the field on which he had pitched his tent.
- 20 There **he erected an altar** and called it **El-Elohe-Israel**.
- 35.1 **El said to Jacob [at Shechem]**, "Arise, go up to Bethel, and settle there. Make an altar there to **El who appeared** to you when you fled from your brother Esau."...
- 4 Jacob came to Luz (that is, Bethel), which is in the land of Canaan, he and all the people who were with him...
- 6 So they gave to Jacob all the foreign gods that they had, and the rings that were in their ears; and Jacob hid them under the **oak that was near Shechem**.
- 7 and there he built an altar and called the place El-bethel, because it was there that El had revealed himself to him when he fled from his brother.
