

“Rejoicing” (Greek, *echarē*), in Luke-Acts

Luke’s Gospel

1.14	You will have joy and gladness, and many will rejoice <u>at his birth</u> ...
1.28	“And he came to her and said, “ Rejoice , favored one! <u>The Lord is with you.</u> ”
6.23	“ Rejoice in that day and leap for joy, for surely <u>your reward is great in heaven</u> ; for that is what their ancestors did to the prophets.”
10.20	“Nevertheless, <u>do not rejoice</u> at this, <u>that the spirits submit to you</u> , but rejoice that <u>your names are written in heaven.</u> ”
13.17	When he said this, all his opponents were put to shame; and the entire crowd was rejoicing <u>at all the wonderful things that he was doing.</u>
15.5	<u>When he has found it</u> , he lays it on his shoulders and rejoices .
15.32	“But we had to celebrate and rejoice , because <u>this brother of yours was dead and has come to life</u> ; he was lost and has been found.”
19.6	So [Zacchaeus] hurried down and rejoiced <u>to welcome him.</u>
19.37	As he was now approaching the path down from the Mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to praise God joyfully with a loud voice <u>for all the deeds of power that they had seen</u> ...
22.5	They rejoiced greatly and <u>agreed to give him money.</u>
23.8	When <u>Herod</u> saw Jesus, he rejoiced , for he had been wanting to see him for a long time, because he had heard about him and was <u>hoping to see him perform some sign.</u>

Acts of the Apostles

5.41	As they left the council, they rejoiced that they were <u>considered worthy to suffer dishonor for the sake of the name.</u>
8.39	When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord snatched Philip away; the <u>eunuch</u> saw him no more, and went on his way rejoicing .
11.23	When [Barnabas] came <u>and saw the grace of God</u> , he rejoiced , and he exhorted them all to remain faithful to the Lord with steadfast devotion;
13.48	When the <u>Gentiles heard this</u> , they rejoiced and praised the word of the Lord; and as many as had been destined for eternal life became believers. of God...
15.23	"The brothers, both the apostles and the elders, to the believers of Gentile origin in Antioch and Syria and Cilicia, rejoice! "
15.31	When its members read it, they rejoiced <u>at the exhortation.</u>
23.26	"Claudius Lysias to his Excellency the governor Felix, rejoice. "
