11:2-5: David and Bathsheba: conception of unnamed child
11:6-15: David and Uriah (framed by messages to Joab about Uriah): Uriah lies on the ground and won't eat
11:16-25: David and Joab (via messengers)
11:26-27: Bathsheba goes to David: "YHWH saw
that it was evil"
12:1-14: YHWH sends Nathan to David: the parable
and response
12:15-23: David and YHWH: the dying and mourning of the "love child":
David lays on the ground and won't eat
12:24-25: David and Bathsheba: conception and birth of Solomon
