

Genesis 36 keywords

[genealogy]

These are the descendants of Esau (that is, Edom). Esau took his **women** from the Canaanites: Adah **daughter** of Elon the Hittite, Oholibamah **daughter** of Anah **son** of Zibeon the Hivite, and Basemath, Ishmael's **daughter**, sister of Nebaioth. Adah bore Eliphaz to Esau; Basemath bore Reuel; and Oholibamah bore Jeush, Jalam, and Korah. These are the **sons** of Esau who were born to him in the **land** of Canaan.

Then Esau took his **women**, his **sons**, his **daughters**, and all the members of his household, his cattle, all his livestock, and all the property he had acquired in the **land** of Canaan; and he moved to a **land** some distance from his brother Jacob. For their possessions were too great for them to live together; the **land** where they were staying could not support them because of their livestock [13.6]. So Esau settled in the hill country of Seir; **Esau is Edom**. These are the descendants of Esau, father of the Edomites, in the hill country of Seir.

These are the names of Esau's sons: Eliphaz **son** of Adah the **woman** of Esau; Reuel, the son of Esau's woman Basemath. The **sons** of Eliphaz were Teman, Omar, Zepho, Gatam, and Kenaz. (Timna was a concubine of Eliphaz, Esau's **son**; she bore Amalek to Eliphaz.) These were the sons of Adah, Esau's **woman**. These were the **sons** of Reuel: Nahath, Zerah, Shammah, and Mizzah. These were the sons of Esau's woman Basemath. These were the sons of Esau's woman Oholibamah, **daughter** of Anah **son** of Zibeon: she bore to Esau Jeush, Jalam, and Korah.

[leadership/social group]

These are the chief/clans of the sons of Esau. The **sons** of Eliphaz the firstborn of Esau: the **chief/clans** Teman, Omar, Zepho, Kenaz, Korah, Gatam, and Amalek; these are the **chief/clans** of Eliphaz in the **land** of Edom; they are the sons of Adah. These are the **sons** of Esau's **son** Reuel: the **chief/clans** Nahath, Zerah, Shammah, and Mizzah; these are the **chief/clans** of Reuel in the **land** of Edom; they are the sons of Esau's woman Basemath. These are the sons of Esau's woman Oholibamah: the **chief/clans** Jeush, Jalam, and Korah; these are the **chief/clans** born of Esau's **woman** Oholibamah, the **daughter** of Anah. These are the **sons** of **Esau (that is, Edom)**, and these are their **chief/clans**.

[geography]

These are the sons of Seir the Horite, the inhabitants of the land: Lotan, Shobal, Zibeon, Anah, Dishon, Ezer, and Dishan; these are the chief/clans of the Horites, the **sons** of Seir in the **land** of Edom. The **sons** of Lotan were Hori and Heman; and Lotan's sister was Timna. These are the **sons** of Shobal: Alvan, Manahath, Ebal, Shepho, and Onam. These are the **sons** of Zibeon: Aiah and Anah; he is the Anah who found the springs in the wilderness, as he pastured the donkeys of his father Zibeon. These are the children of Anah: Dishon and Oholibamah **daughter** of Anah. These are the **sons** of Dishon: Hemdan, Eshban, Ithran, and Cheran. These are the **sons** of Ezer: Bilhan, Zaavan, and Akan. These are the **sons** of Dishan: Uz and Aran. These are the chief/clans of the Horites: the **chief/clans** Lotan, Shobal, Zibeon, Anah, Dishon, Ezer, and Dishan; these are the chief/clans of the Horites, **chief/clan** by **chief/clan** in the **land** of Seir.

[political authority]

These are the kings who reigned in the land of Edom, before any **king** reigned over the Israelites. Bela **son** of Beor reigned in Edom, the name of his city being Dinhabah. Bela **died**, and Jobab **son** of Zerah of Bozrah succeeded him as **king**. Jobab **died**, and Husham of the **land** of the Temanites succeeded him as **king**. Husham **died**, and Hadad **son** of Bedad, who defeated Midian in the country of Moab, succeeded him as **king**, the name of his city being Avith. Hadad **died**, and Samlah of Masrekah succeeded him as **king**. Samlah **died**, and Shaul of Rehoboth on the Euphrates succeeded him as **king**. Shaul **died**, and Baal-hanan **son** of Achbor succeeded him as **king**. Baal-hanan **son** of Achbor **died**, and Hadar succeeded him as **king**, the name of his city being Pau; his **woman's** name was Mehetabel, the **daughter** of Matred, **daughter** of Me-zahab. These are the names of the **chief/clans** of Esau, according to their families and their localities by their names: the **chief/clans** Timna, Alvah, Jetheth, Oholibamah, Elah, Pinon, Kenaz, Teman, Mibzar, Magdiel, and Iram; these are the **chief/clans** of **Edom (that is, Esau, the father of Edom)**, according to their settlements in the **land** that they held.
