4.8	Woe to us! Who can <b>deliver us</b> from the power of these mighty gods? These are the gods who struck the Egyptians with every sort of plague in the wilderness.
7.3	Then Samuel said to all the house of Israel, "If you are returning to YHWH with all your heart, then put away the foreign gods and the Astartes from among you. Direct your heart to YHWH, and serve him only, and <b>he will deliver you</b> out of the hand of the Philistines."
