David as writer/subject of Scripture

David as a person

1.16	"Friends, the scripture had to be fulfilled, which the <u>Holy Spirit through David</u> foretold concerning Judas..."
2.25	"For <u>David says concerning him</u> , 'I saw the Lord always before me, for he is at my right hand so that I will not be shaken..."
2.29	"Fellow Israelites, I may say to you confidently of our ancestor David that <u>he both died and was buried</u> , and his tomb is with us to this day."
2.34	"For David did not ascend into the heavens, but <u>he himself says</u> , 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand..."
4.25	"...it is you [God] who said <u>by the Holy Spirit through our ancestor David</u> , your servant: 'Why did the Gentiles rage, and the peoples imagine vain things?'"
7.45b-46	"And [the tent of testimony] was there <u>until the time of David</u> , who found favor with God and asked that he might find a dwelling place for the house of Jacob."
13.22-23	"When [[God] had removed [Saul], he made David <u>their king</u> . In his testimony about him he said, 'I have found David , son of Jesse, to be a man after my heart, who will carry out all my wishes.' Of this man's posterity God has brought to Israel a Savior, Jesus, as he promised..."
13.34-37	"As to his raising him from the dead, no more to return to corruption, he has spoken in this way, 'I will give you <u>the holy promises made to David</u> .' Therefore he has also said in another psalm, 'You will not let your Holy One experience corruption.' For David , after he had served the purpose of God in his own generation, died, was laid beside his ancestors, and experienced corruption; but he whom God raised up experienced no corruption."
15.16-17a	"After this I will return, and I will rebuild <u>the dwelling of David</u> , which has fallen; from its ruins I will rebuild it, and I will set it up, so that all other peoples may seek the Lord-- even all the Gentiles over whom my name has been called."
