

"Israel" in Acts

1.6	So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, is this <u>the time when you will restore the kingdom to Israel?</u> "
2.22, 29	"You that are Israelites , listen to what I have to say..." " <u>Fellow Israelites</u> , I may say to you confidently..."
2.36	"Therefore let <u>the entire house of Israel</u> know with certainty that God has made him both Lord and Messiah, this Jesus whom you crucified."
3.12	When Peter saw it, he addressed the people, " <u>You Israelites...</u> "
4.10	"let it be known to all of you, and to <u>all the people of Israel</u> , that this man is standing before you in good health by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead."
4.27	"For in this city, in fact, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the <u>peoples of Israel</u> , gathered together against your holy servant Jesus, whom you anointed..."
5.21	When the high priest and those with him arrived, they called together the council and the <u>whole body of the elders of Israel</u> and sent to the prison to have them brought.
5.31	"God exalted him at his right hand as Leader and Savior <u>that he might give repentance to Israel</u> and forgiveness of sins."
5.35	Then [Gamaliel] said to them, " <u>Fellow Israelites...</u> "
7.23, 37	"When [Moses] was forty years old, it came into his heart to visit his relatives, the IsraelitesThis is the <u>Moses who said to the Israelites</u> , 'God will raise up a prophet for you from your own people as he raised me up.'"
7.42	"But God turned away from them and handed them over to worship the host of heaven, as it is written in the book of the prophets: 'Did you offer to me slain victims and sacrifices forty years in the wilderness, <u>O house of Israel?</u> '"
9.15	But the Lord said to [Saul], "Go, for he is an instrument whom I have chosen to bring my name before Gentiles and kings and before <u>the people of Israel...</u> "
10.36	"You know the message he sent to <u>the people of Israel</u> , preaching peace by Jesus Christ--he is Lord of all."
13.16-17, 23-24	Paul stood up and with a gesture began to speak: " <u>You Israelites, and others who fear God</u> , listen. The God of <u>this people Israel</u> chose our ancestors and made the people great during their stay in the land of Egypt, and with uplifted arm he led them out of it.... <u>Of this man's posterity God has brought to Israel a Savior, Jesus</u> , as he promised; before his coming John had already proclaimed a baptism of repentance to all the people of Israel."
21.27d-28	They seized him, shouting, " <u>Fellow Israelites</u> , help! This is the man who is teaching everyone everywhere against our people, our law, and this place"
28.20	"For this reason therefore I [Paul] have asked to see you and speak with you, since it is <u>for the sake of the hope of Israel</u> that I am bound with this chain."
