

Some "cloud" passages related to Acts 1.9

Exodus 13.21-22	YHWH went in front of them in a pillar of cloud by day, to lead them along the way, and in a pillar of fire by night, to give them light, so that they might travel by day and by night. Neither the pillar of cloud by day nor the pillar of fire by night left its place in front of the people.
16.10	And as Aaron spoke to the whole congregation of the Israelites, they looked toward the wilderness, and the glory of YHWH appeared in the cloud.
24.15-18	Then Moses went up on the mountain, and the cloud covered the mountain. The glory of YHWH settled on Mount Sinai, and the cloud covered it for six days; on the seventh day he called to Moses out of the cloud Now the appearance of the glory of YHWH was like a devouring fire on the top of the mountain in the sight of the people of Israel Moses entered the cloud, and went up on the mountain. Moses was on the mountain for forty days and forty nights.
40.34-38	Then the cloud covered the tent of meeting, and the glory of YHWH filled the tabernacle. Moses was not able to enter the tent of meeting because the cloud settled upon it, and the glory of YHWH filled the tabernacle. Whenever the cloud was taken up from the tabernacle, the Israelites would set out on each stage of their journey; but if the cloud was not taken up, then they did not set out until the day that it was taken up. For the cloud of YHWH was on the tabernacle by day, and fire was in the cloud by night, before the eyes of all the house of Israel at each stage of their journey.
Numbers 9.15-22	On the day the tabernacle was set up, the cloud covered the tabernacle, the tent of the covenant; and from evening until morning it was over the tabernacle, having the appearance of fire. It was always so: the cloud covered it by day and the appearance of fire by night. Whenever the cloud lifted from over the tent, then the Israelites would set out; and in the place where the cloud settled down, there the Israelites would camp. At the command of YHWH the Israelites would set out, and at the command of YHWH they would camp. As long as the cloud rested over the tabernacle, they would remain in camp. Even when the cloud continued over the tabernacle many days, the Israelites would keep the charge of YHWH, and would not set out. Sometimes the cloud would remain a few days over the tabernacle, and according to the command of YHWH they would remain in camp; then according to the command of YHWH they would set out. Sometimes the cloud would remain from evening until morning; and when the cloud lifted in the morning, they would set out, or if it continued for a day and a night, when the cloud lifted they would set out. Whether it was two days, or a month, or a longer time, that the cloud continued over the tabernacle, resting upon it, the Israelites would remain in camp and would not set out; but when it lifted they would set out.
Deuteronomy 31.14b-15	So Moses and Joshua went and presented themselves in the tent of meeting, and YHWH appeared at the tent in a pillar of cloud; the pillar of cloud stood at the entrance to the tent.
1 Kings 8.10-11	And when the priests came out of the holy place, a cloud filled the house of YHWH, so that the priests could not stand to minister because of the cloud; for the glory of YHWH filled the house of YHWH.
Ezekiel 10.3-4	Now the cherubim were standing on the south side of the house when the man went in; and a cloud filled the inner court. Then the glory of YHWH rose up from the cherub to the threshold of the house; the house was filled with the cloud, and the court was full of the brightness of the glory of YHWH.
Psalms 68.4	Sing to God, sing praises to his name; lift up a song to him who rides upon the clouds -- his name is YHWH-- be exultant before him.
Psalms 97.2	Clouds and thick darkness are all around him; righteousness and justice are the foundation of his throne.
