

**“to lie with” (Hebrew, *shkhv*) in the Bible
with sexual connotations (selected examples)**

GENESIS

19.32-35	Come, let us make <u>our father [Lot]</u> drink wine, and we will lie with him, so that we may preserve offspring through our father." So they made their father drink wine that night; and the firstborn went in and lay with her father ; he did not know when she lay down or when she rose. On the next day, the firstborn said to the younger, "Look, I lay last night with my father; let us make him drink wine tonight also; then you go in and lie with him, so that we may preserve offspring through our father." So they made their father drink wine that night also; and the younger rose, and lay with him; and he did not know when she lay down or when she rose.
26.10	Abimelech said, "What is this you have done to us? One of the people might easily have lain with your woman , and you would have brought guilt upon us."
30.15	But [Rachel] said to [Leah], "Is it a small matter that you have taken away my man? Would you take away my son's mandrakes also?" Rachel said, "Then he may lie with you tonight for your son's mandrakes."
34.2, 7	When Shechem son of Hamor the Hivite, prince of the region, saw [<u>Dinah</u>], he seized her and lay with her by forcehe had committed an outrage in Israel by lying with Jacob's daughter, for such a thing ought not to be done.
35.22	While Israel lived in that land, <u>Reuben</u> went and lay with <u>Bilhah</u> his father's concubine; and Israel heard of it.
39.7, 10, 12, 14	[Joseph and Mrs. Potiphar]
Deuteronomy 22.22	If a <u>man</u> is caught lying with the woman of another man , both of them shall die, the man who lay with the woman as well as the woman. So you shall purge the evil from Israel.

2 SAMUEL

11.4	So David sent messengers to get [<u>Bathsheba</u>], and she came to him, and he lay with her.
12.11, 24	Thus says YHWH: I will raise up trouble against you from within your own house; and I will take your wives before your eyes, and give them to your neighbor, and he shall lie with your women in the sight of this very sun....Then David consoled his woman <u>Bathsheba</u> , and went to her and lay with her ; and she bore a son, and he named him Solomon.
13.11	But when [Tamar] brought them near [<u>Amnon</u>] to eat, he took hold of her, and said to her, "Come, lie with me, my sister ."
