"See, my man has brought among us a <b>Hebrew</b> <sup>1</sup> to insult us! (39.,14)	"For in fact I was stolen out of the land of the <b>Hebrews...</b> " (40.15)	"A young <b>Hebrew</b> was there with us, a servant of the captain of the guard..." (41.12)
So Joseph found favor in his sight and <b>attended him...</b> (39.4)	The captain of the guard charged Joseph with them, and <b>he attended them</b> (40.4)	
	Cupbearer/baker <b>dreams</b>	Pharaoh's <b>dreams</b>
she caught hold of his <b>garment</b> , saying, "Lie with me!" But he left his garment in her hand and fled and ran outside. (39.12-18)		[Pharaoh] arrayed [Joseph] <b>in garments</b> of fine linen (41.42)
