

Mention of God in Genesis 42-45

42.18	On the third day Joseph said to them, "Do this and you will live, for <u>I fear God</u> "
42.28	He said to his brothers, "My money has been put back; here it is in my sack!" At this they lost heart and turned trembling to one another, saying, "What is this that <u>God has done to us?</u> "
43.13-14a	[Jacob]: "Take your brother also and be on your way again to the man; may <u>God Almighty grant you mercy before the man</u> , so that he may send back your other brother and Benjamin."
43.23	[Joseph's steward] replied, "Rest assured, do not be afraid; your <u>God and the God of your father must have put treasure in your sacks</u> for you; I received your money."
43.29	Then he looked up and saw his brother Benjamin, his mother's son, and said, "Is this your youngest brother, of whom you spoke to me? <u>God be gracious to you, my son!</u> "
44.16	And Judah said, "What can we say to my lord? What can we speak? How can we clear ourselves? <u>God has found out the guilt of your servants</u> "
45.5-9	"And now do not be distressed, or angry with yourselves, because you sold me here; for <u>God sent me before you to preserve life</u> . For the famine has been in the land these two years; and there are five more years in which there will be neither plowing nor harvest. <u>God sent me before you to preserve for you a remnant on earth</u> , and to keep alive for you many survivors. So it was not you who sent me here, but <u>God; he has made me a father to Pharaoh, and lord of all his house and ruler over all the land of Egypt</u> . Hurry and go up to my father and say to him, 'Thus says your son Joseph, <u>God has made me lord of all Egypt</u> ; come down to me, do not delay.'
