

Language of destruction/domination in 2 Samuel 22.38-51

v. 38: destroyed them

v. 38: consumed them

v. 39: struck them down

v. 39: they fell under my feet

v. 40: those standing bow/kneel under me

v. 41: they give their necks to me

v. 41: I destroyed them

v. 42: no one to save them

v. 43: beat them fine like dust

v. 43: crushed them

v. 43: stamped them down like street mire

v. 44: kept me as head of the nations

v. 44: unknown peoples served me

v. 45: foreigners came cringing before me

v. 45: foreigners obeyed me

v. 46: foreigners wither/fall, trembling

v. 48: peoples under me

v. 49: exalted me above adversaries
