

YHWH as Storm God in the Hebrew Bible

Deuteronomy 33.26	There is none like God, O Jeshurun, who rides through the heavens to your help, majestic through the skies.
Isaiah 19.1	YHWH is riding on a swift cloud and comes to Egypt; the idols of Egypt will tremble at his presence, and the heart of the Egyptians will melt within them.
Psalm 104.2-6	You stretch out the heavens like a tent, you set the beams of your chambers on the waters, you make the clouds your chariot, you ride on the wings of the wind, you make the winds your messengers, fire and flame your ministers. You set the earth on its foundations, so that it shall never be shaken. You cover it with the deep as with a garment; the waters stood above the mountains.
Psalm 68.4	Sing to God, sing praises to his name; lift up a song to him who rides upon the clouds -- his name is YHWH-- be exultant before him.

Excerpts from "Baal Cycle" (Ugarit, 13th century BCE)

1.3 IV: 25–27 May **Baal** set his harness in [the Heavens],
May [the Clo]ud[rider] radiate his [ho]rns.

1.4 V: 6–7 So now **may Baal make his rain abundant,**
May he make the water greatly abundant in a downpour,
8–9 And may he give his voice in the clouds,
May he flash to the earth lightning.
