

Threshing floors in the Hebrew Bible

Numbers 15.20	From your first batch of dough you shall present a loaf as a donation; you shall present it just as you present a donation from the threshing floor .
Numbers 18.27	[The tithe of the tithe] shall be reckoned to you as your gift, the same as the grain of the threshing floor and the fullness of the wine press.
Deuteronomy 15.14	Provide liberally out of your flock, your threshing floor and your wine press, thus giving to [the freed slave] some of the bounty with which YHWH your God has blessed you.
Deuteronomy 16.13	You shall keep the festival of booths for seven days, when you have gathered in the produce from your threshing floor and your wine press.
Judges 6.36-37	Then Gideon said to God, "In order to see whether you will deliver Israel by my hand, as you have said, I am going to lay a fleece of wool on the threshing floor ; if there is dew on the fleece alone, and it is dry on all the ground, then I shall know that you will deliver Israel by my hand, as you have said."
1 Samuel 23.1	Now they told David, "The Philistines are fighting against Keilah, and are robbing the threshing floors ."
2 Samuel 24.16, 18, 21, 24 [= 1 Chronicles 21.18-28]	But when the angel stretched out his hand toward Jerusalem to destroy it, YHWH relented concerning the evil, and said to the angel who was bringing destruction among the people, "It is enough; now stay your hand." The angel of YHWH was then by the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite....That day Gad came to David and said to him, "Go up and erect an altar to YHWH on the threshing floor of Araunah the Jebusite."... Araunah said, "Why has my lord the king come to his servant?" David said, "To buy the threshing floor from you in order to build an altar to YHWH, so that the plague may be averted from the people."... But the king said to Araunah, "No, but I will buy them from you for a price; I will not offer burnt offerings to YHWH my God that cost me nothing." So David bought the threshing floor and the oxen for fifty shekels of silver.
1 Kings 22.10 [= 2 Chronicles 18.9]	Now the king of Israel and King Jehoshaphat of Judah were sitting on their thrones, arrayed in their robes, at the threshing floor at the entrance of the gate of Samaria; and all the prophets were prophesying before them.
2 Kings 6.26-27	Now as the king of Israel was walking on the city wall, a woman cried out to him, "Help, my lord king!" He said, "No! Let YHWH help you. How can I help you? From the threshing floor or from the wine press?"
Jeremiah 51.33	For thus says YHWH of hosts, the God of Israel: Daughter Babylon is like a threshing floor at the time when it is trodden; yet a little while and the time of her harvest will come.
Hosea 9.1	Do not rejoice, O Israel! Do not exult as other nations do; for you have played the whore, departing from your God. You have loved a prostitute's pay on all threshing floors .
Hosea 13.3	Therefore they shall be like the morning mist or like the dew that goes away early, like chaff that swirls from the threshing floor or like smoke from a window.
Joel 2.24	The threshing floors shall be full of grain, the vats shall overflow with wine and oil.
Micah 4.12	But they do not know the thoughts of YHWH; they do not understand his plan, that he has gathered them as sheaves to the threshing floor .
Job 39.12	Do you have faith in [the wild ox] that it will return, and bring your grain to your threshing floor ?
Ruth 3.2-3	Now here is our kinsman Boaz, with whose young women you have been working. See, he is winnowing barley tonight at the threshing floor . Now wash and anoint yourself and put on your best clothes and go down to the threshing floor ; but do not make yourself known to the man until he has finished eating and drinking.
2 Chronicles 3.1	Solomon began to build the house of YHWH in Jerusalem on Mount Moriah, where YHWH had appeared to his father David, at the place that David had designated, on the threshing floor of Ornan the Jebusite.
